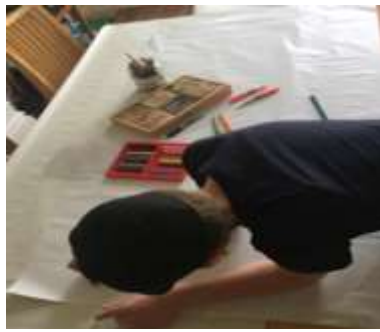


To my lovely group.
